	has made a huge impact across Careers/Information Guidance and Education. It is apparent that there is a need for more resources in this area during the next 12 months. Giving students access to employers is one of our weaknesses. We should be asking alumni back in, getting Governors to talk to students, and working with local businesses. Tina White is the governor link with careers CVCC is obliged to inform pupils about apprenticeship, but this is slightly contentious as if students go down the apprenticeship route they do not stay at CVCC for Post 16. The apprenticeship scheme needs to be added to the Career Policy. Currently there is a successful work experience week for year 10, Julia Knowles works one day a week as the Next Steps South West co-ordinator. All placements are thoroughly checked. The system we are moving to is very similar to that of the 1990s, but does have time implications and resource implications. The major challenge CVCC faces is that it is a rural school with not a lot of local employers, thus giving problems particularly with aspirational placements.		
17/18.16	Monitoring (Standing Item) This item was brought to the beginning of the meeting so that Dave Walters could leave promptly. DW reported that there was a new Ofsted Inspection Dashboard (ISDR). An inspection could be just for one day, and the inspector would want the information immediately. DW had produced the overall summary of last year, which shows an improving picture and providing cautious optimism. Year 11 are in the safe zone, having come in from a slightly lower base line. One child came in for one day in September and not since, this drags down the statistics. Year 11 are the immediate priority. SAIF codes: Students are categorised code 0 – code 5, with code 5 being severe. In year 11, 28 students are code 4/5. Year 8 is a concern with 30 students on code 5, of which 10 are female and 20 are male. Staff have been asked to raise the levels in Year 8, and strategically we need to look at how we organise Year 8. Year 13 are currently doing mock exams. DW left at 6.10pm	DW	
17/18.17	Use of Funds for Disadvantaged Learners – Standing Item August 2017 Seven students performed very badly, of which six were disadvantaged learners. When you take these 6 out, the figures are much less of a concern. Year 11 is a bit more rosy – the progress gap is narrowing. CVCC has bought software for students to create a "play list" of their revision podcasts. Julia Knowles is helping them all log on and get going. 50% of Year 11 are already using this app.	AG
