- We are following the Edexcel 3-year Linear Scheme of Work
- Foundation Grades 1-5, Higher Grades 4-9
- All students have 3 exams at the end of year 11: Paper 1 non-calculator, Papers 2 and 3 calculator
- Each exam is out of 80 and will last for 90 minutes
- All 3 exam papers will contain questions from the 5 main areas of maths:

Number, Algebra, Ratio, Shape, Data

- Miss Mann's Set 7 will be doing the AQA Entry Level Certificate as well as a GCSE in Maths
- Mr Turnock's Set 1 students will be offered the option of completing a second maths qualification:

AQA Level 2 Certificate in Further Maths. This will focus on grade 8/9 topics and some parts of the AS Maths course and will be taught remotely through Teams

• Students must bring the following equipment to all lessons and all exams:

Casio Calculator FX83(85), black pen, pencil, red pen, highlighter, ruler, protractor, compasses

- All students have been given a target grade
- All students have a maths book in which they write their notes, complete their homework and do practice questions and problem -solving tasks.
- Homework is set once a week on THURSDAY and is set on Teams. Students are expected to write their workings in their maths books and load the answers onto Teams. The deadline is midnight on MONDAY
- All students will have an internal assessment at the end of each term
- We recommend that students who wish to do extra practice on particular topics look at 'Corbett Maths' videos and work sheets. Any extra worksheets that are completed will be marked by maths staff. This extra practice will be essential in year 11 as part of each student's revision for Maths. Clip numbers are on the Schemes of Work that can be found on the school website
- In year 11 we start to look at Exam Papers as homework after October half term
- All students have access to My Maths (login: clyst, password: expand) and the GCSE textbook on the Kerboodle website
