Students are also offered the opportunity to follow Sports Leaders accreditation.

In addition, the department offers GCSE in Physical Education (AQA) as well as Btec Sport (Level 2), 'AS' and 'A2' Physical Education (AQA). Numbers are among the highest in the College.

It is intended that the programme offered, together with an awareness of the leisure opportunities within the community, will develop those skills and attributes conducive to involvement in an active lifestyle.

The department enjoys a strong relationship with Performing Arts and works collaboratively with Music, Drama and Dance. Consequently, many students are encouraged to participate in the extensive extra-curricular programme catering for all ability levels, activities including: Dance, Rugby, Soccer, Netball, Rounders, Athletics, Tennis, Basketball, Cricket, Gymnastics and Volleyball.
