<u>Iceland Geography Trip 2017: Tuesday 18 July - Saturday 22 July 2017</u>

We have had a considerable amount of interest in the Iceland Trip and we are now in a position to take deposits. This will be an exciting opportunity for all students studying Geography and will not only completely enhance their study of hazards, but also provide an opportunity to experience Iceland's amazing scenery and volcanic activity. We will be travelling with WST travel company, from Heathrow airport with scheduled flights. The trip will be for four nights and five days - from Tuesday 18 July to Saturday 22 July 2017. We will be staying, full-board, at the Hotel Ork, a three star hotel approximately 30 minutes from Reykjavik, with its own geothermal swimming pool. The trip itinerary is detailed below:

Day 5	A guided exploration of Reykjavik before transferring to the airport for your return flight home.

Payment Plan

- 5th payment of £150.00 to be paid by Thursday 24 November 2016
- 6th payment of £100.00 to be paid by Thursday 2 March 2017
- Final payment of £70.00 must be paid by Thursday 20 April 2017

Once the final payment has been made to the tour company (3 May 2017), no refunds can be given.

<u>Current Y9 students:</u> This trip is only available to students who are opting to study Geography at GCSE. The trip will clash with Work Experience Week so, if you wish your child to take part in work experience, you will need to arrange an alternative time for this - for example during the summer holidays.

<u>Current Y10 students</u>: This trip is only available to students who are currently studying GCSE Geography.

<u>Current Y11 students</u>: Students must be attending Clyst Vale Sixth Form and they should also be intending to study Geography A level.

If you would like your child to take part, please make the first payment by **Monday 7 March 2016**, as detailed below. There will be a parents' Information Evening later in the year to give you all the information you need about the trip.
