In total, you will study 9 GCSE level subjects throughout Year 10 & Year 11. 5 of these subjects are made up of the 'Core Subjects':

- 1. English Language
- 2. English Literature
- 3. Maths
- 4. Science (General Science is a Double Award subject, the equivalent of 2 GCSEs; you may opt for Separate Sciences instead Biology, Chemistry, Physics. Separate Sciences is the equivalent of 3 GCSEs, and takes up one of your Free Option Choices.)
