Year 10 GCSE Art and Photography Trip to the Eden Project: Tuesday 27 September 2016

The above Study Day will take place on Tuesday 27 September 2016 for all Year 10 Art and Photography students to visit the Eden Project. Students will be given time to explore the Eden Project site. They will complete research and practical tasks that will enable them to record their experiences. This trip will provide students with the fantastic opportunity to develop their GCSE coursework creatively in response to the inspirational environment of the Eden Project.

Travel will be by coach, **leaving Clyst Vale at 8.00am and returning by approximately 6.00pm.** Students will need to be collected or have arrangements made for their return home. They will require a packed lunch and will need to bring money if they wish to purchase postcards etc in the shop, and refreshments throughout the day. Students are not required to wear school uniform, but need to wear appropriate clothing for both indoor and outdoor conditions.

The total cost per student for the trip is **£15.00**. This price covers the return coach travel and the Eden Project entrance fee.
